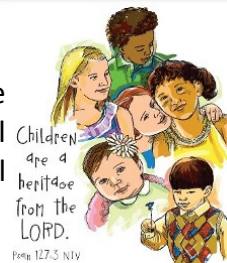
SONSHINE SISTERS
