Joe Akins' mother remains in the hospital near Memphis, TN and is still in very serious condition. Joe appreciates your prayers for her.

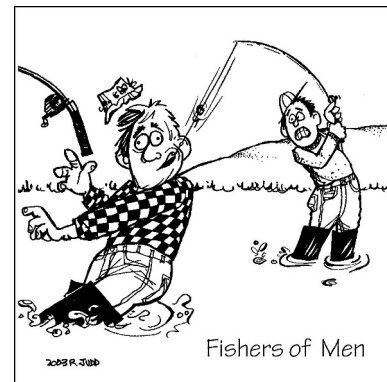

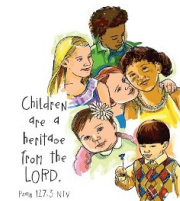
