VBS is Coming

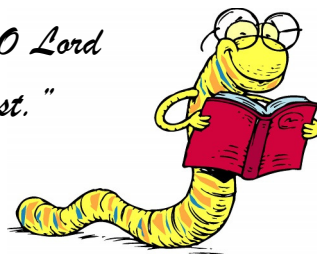

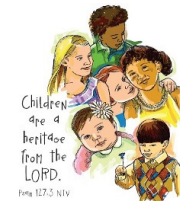

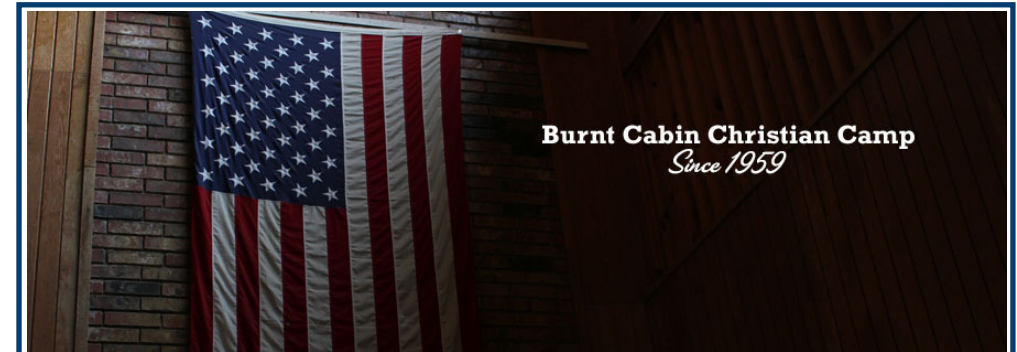
