May God bless us in our study of singing to Him in worship.

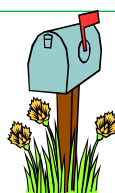

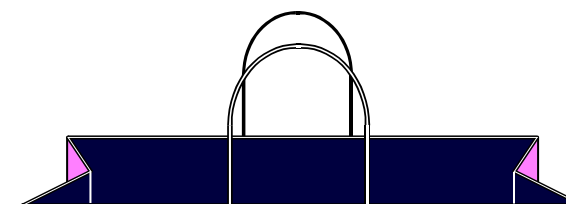

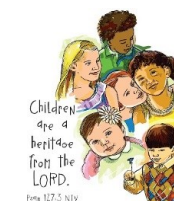
