**"In reply Jesus declared, "I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again."**

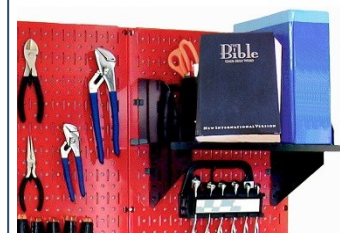

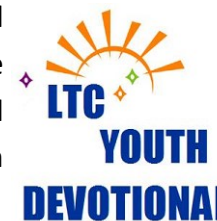

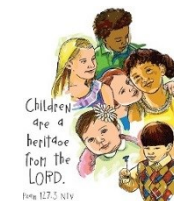
