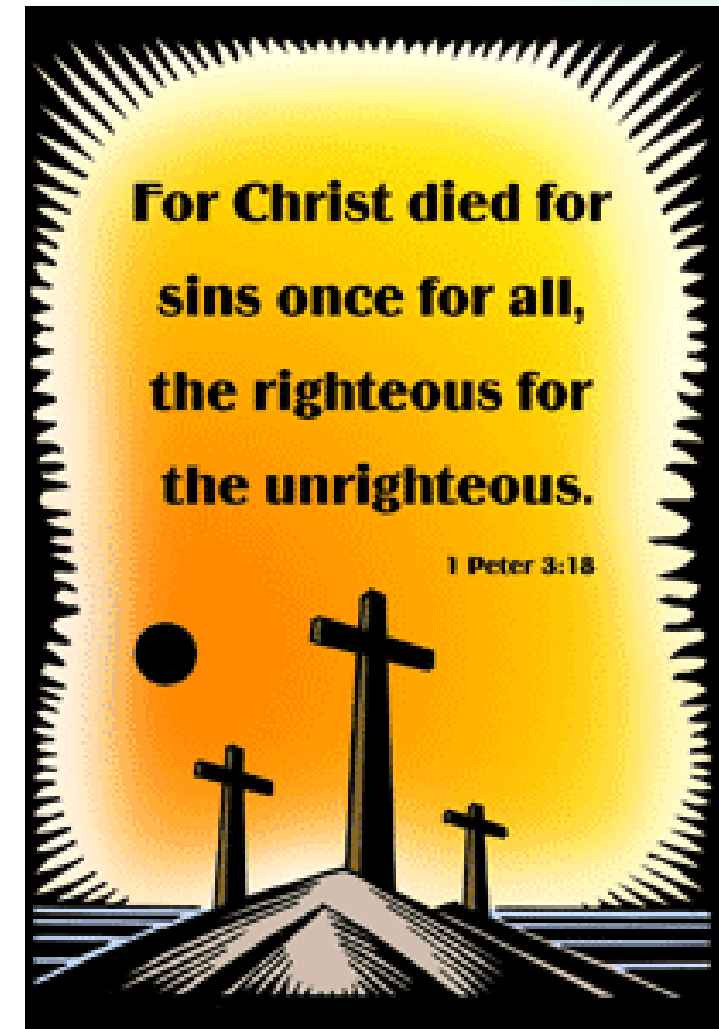

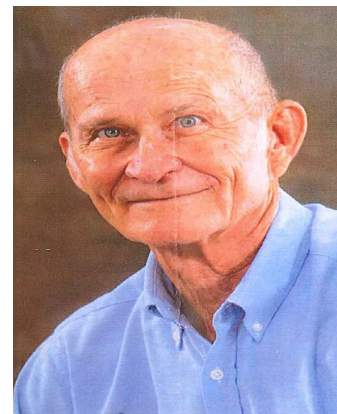
"Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled." Matthew 5:6

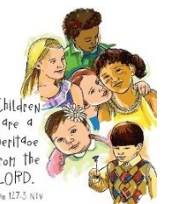
