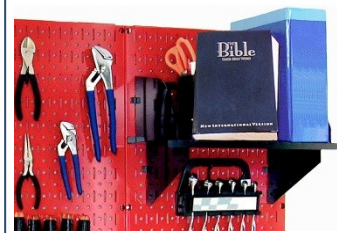
### Call her Blessed

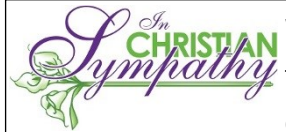

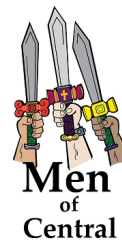

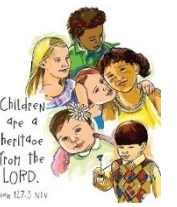


## GOSPEL MEETING
