CALLING VBS LEADERS



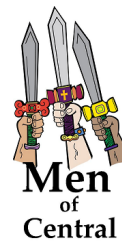
We need adults to help with VBS. Everyone that is able to help in any way is encouraged to sign up on the sheet in the foyer. There are many areas to choose to help in.

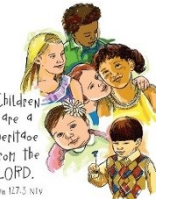
