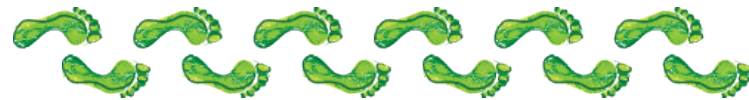


## THANK YOU NOTES

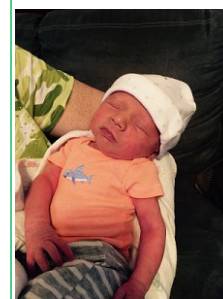

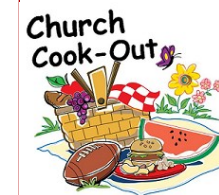
