We have a Family Retreat planned for October 23rd and 24th at Burnt Cabin Christian Camp. Mark your calendars and more details will be coming soon.

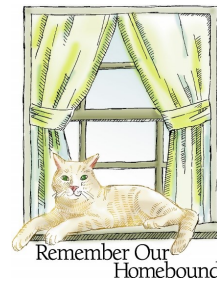
## PRAYER CONCERNS

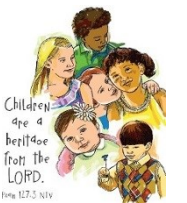
## ELEVATION TRAMPOLINE PARK
