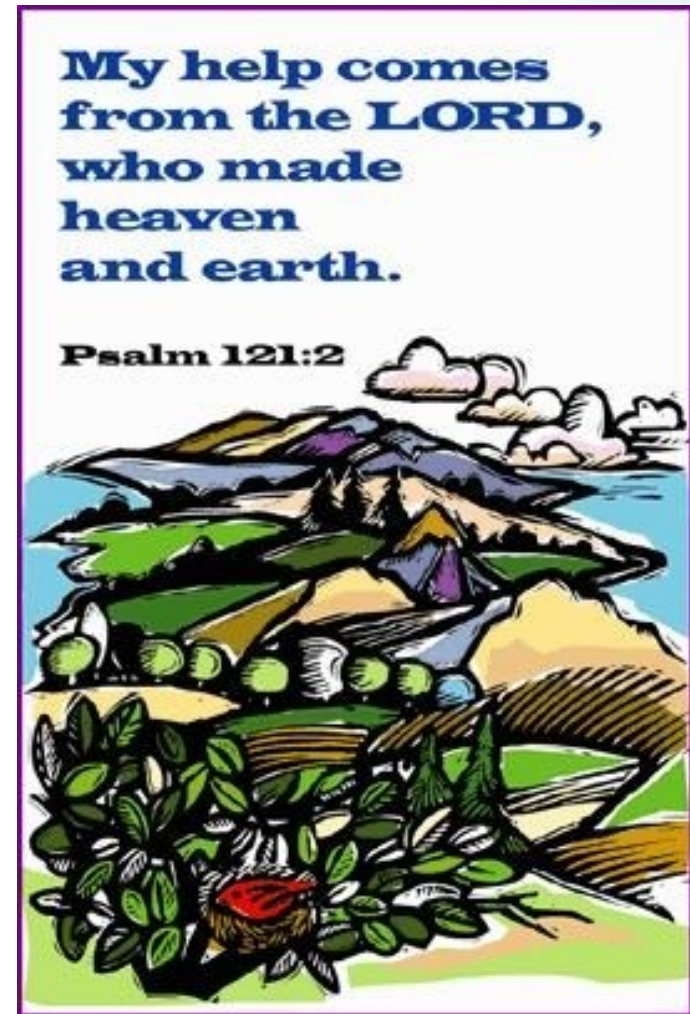

Make sure to come together this Lord's day and every opportunity you have. Enjoy the fervor of His love.

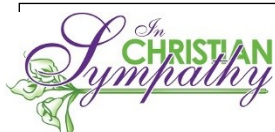

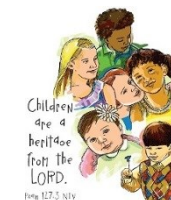
