YOUTH NEWS

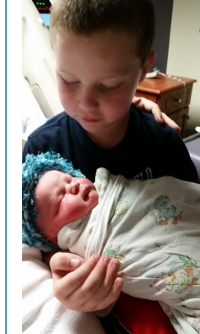

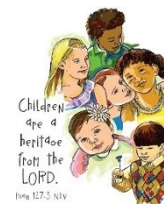
