PRAYER CONCERNS

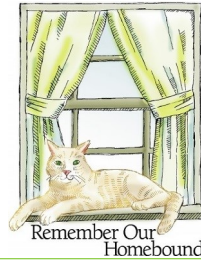

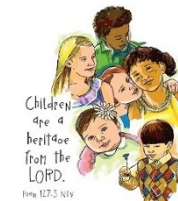
