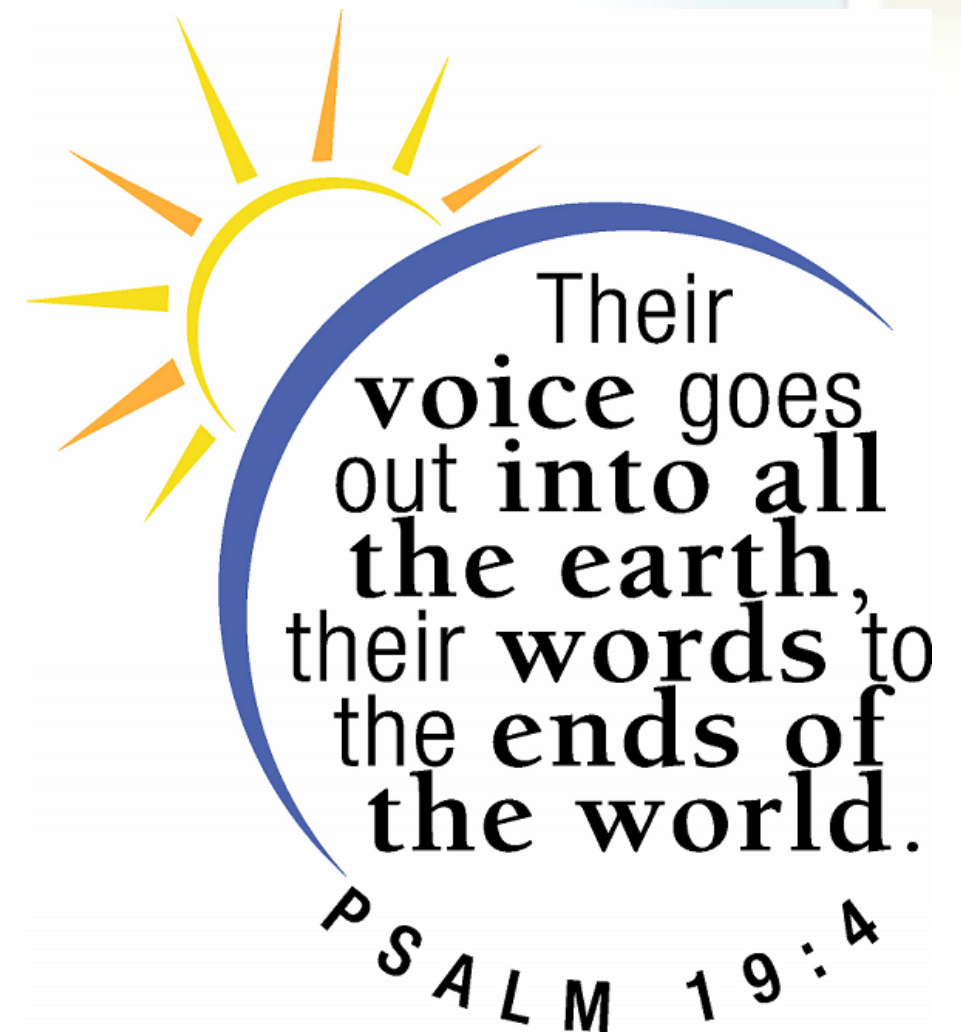

Dr. Francis Davis was born into the body of Christ many years ago following a gospel meeting at Central with brother **Jimmy Allen**. He was strong in his political views, in caring for his family, being an outstanding citizen and neighbor, being a compassionate physician, and serving the Lord. He made house calls in his early practice and was often paid from people's gardens. No one was ever turned away who needed to see a doctor. He published a magazine called *Private Practice* that had a large circulation for a number of years. In the fall of the year he would drive in from Dallas with his car completely filled with coats he had found to be given to Central for the annual coat give-away.
