"If your brother sins against you, go and show him his fault, just between the two of you." Matthew 18:15 NIV


Is Jesus contradicting Himself here. No I don't think so. Let's join together this Lord's day to study and seek God's wisdom on the difference between judgement and discernment.

September 26th and 27th marks the beginning of perhaps the biggest outreach effort in a generation for the Central Church of Christ in Shawnee. The Northwest Church of Christ in Lawton will share a methodology they

have perfected with tremendous results since 1976 during a two-day workshop on these days. The Northwest group is sending an outreach team in the summer of 2017 and our preparations to help them help us spread the good news of Christ starts this month.

The workshops include classes on Saturday evening September 26, continuing during our worship time on Sunday September 27, and concluding with a special meeting following lunch on that Sunday. The workshops focus on building personal evangelism skills and preparing the congregation for success. This effort in 2017 will require many different talents including food preparation, childcare services, transportation, and many other support services for the team coming to aid in this effort. Everyone is needed and everyone will have an important role.

The almost 40 campaigns conducted by the Northwest Lawton group in seven states (Colorado, Kansas, Nebraska, Missouri, Oklahoma, Arkansas, and Texas) have produced 1,191 baptisms and 191 restorations. That's an average of 31 baptisms per campaign. The group from Lawton will offer many experienced personal evangelism workers, but they stress that success depends on our preparation between now and the summer of 2017. This upcoming workshop is a first step.

Outreach is fundamental to the Christian faith. Christ himself said, "Go into all the world preach the gospel." As Christians, we have the gift of redemption and the promise of a spiritual eternity with God. As followers of Christ, we must have compassion. If our faith tells us salvation comes through Jesus Christ, we have an obligation to share that simple message to all humanity. The eldership is excited about this effort and believe it to be a good opportunity to spread the gospel in this city. The fields are ready, it is now up to us to prepare for the harvest.
