Joann Cheney has had successful surgery on Monday. She hopes to be able to go home by Thursday. Pray for her recovery and her family.

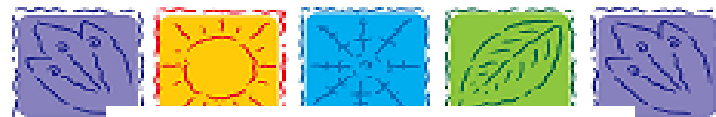

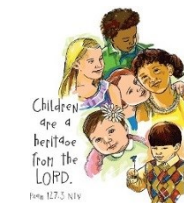
