## PRAYER CONCERNS

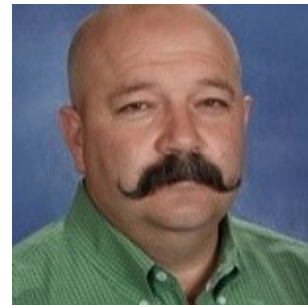
