YOUTH NEWS

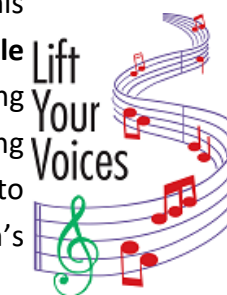
