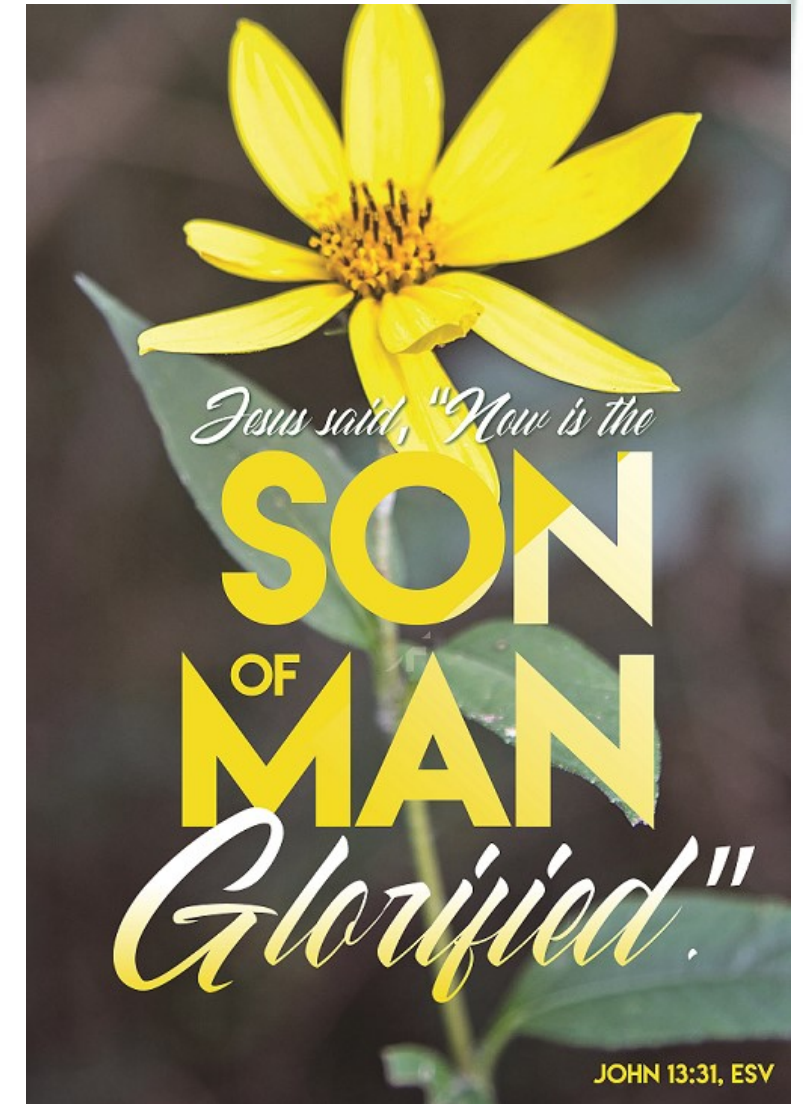

## YOUTH NEWS

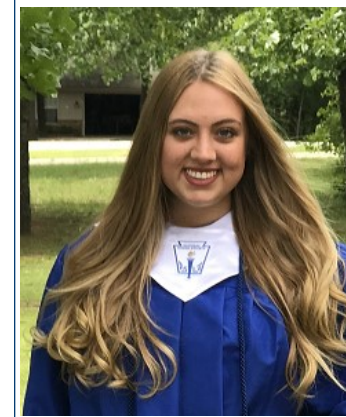
