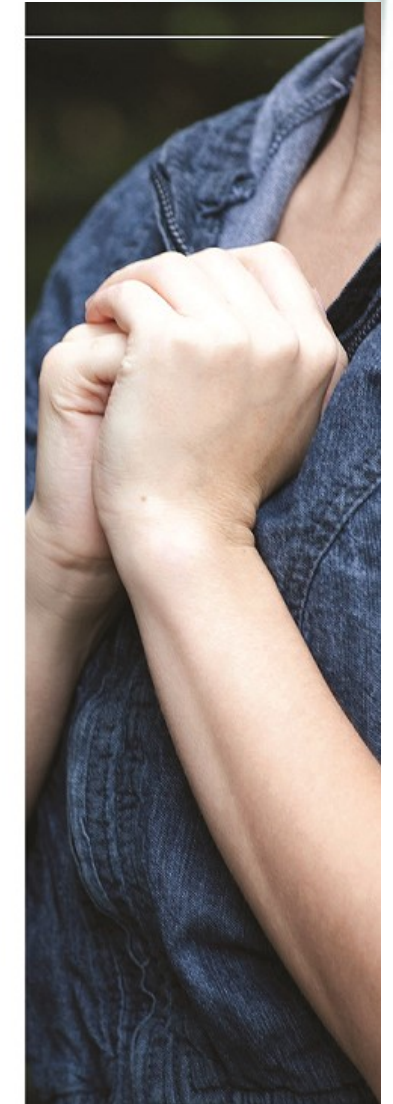

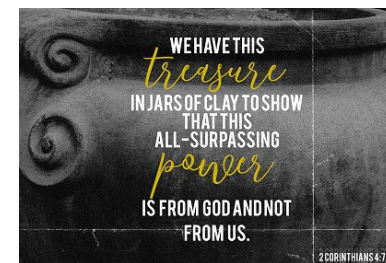


YOUTH NEWS

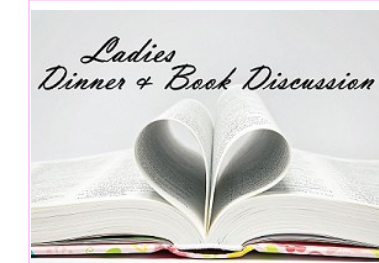
