

1934 Robert Perry 2019

Early Monday morning, September 23, the hearts of **Robert Perry's** family were startled and saddened over his sudden passing from this life to his eternal home. The members of the Central church family were also deeply touched by the loss of this brother who had been their shepherd for so many years. Robert's father, Floyd, had been a highly respected leader in our congregation as well as Robert's son, Bob who serves so well today. Central has served both the community and the brotherhood because of the leadership of many outstanding men, but none have served better than the Perry family. Shawnee lost one of its finest citizens with the loss of Robert. The church lost one of its greatest examples and servants, and heaven has gained one of its finest saints. It's with heartfelt love that we express our sympathy to all the Perrys in the loss of a patriarch whose life was well lived.

Robert's funeral was conducted in the Central building on Thursday, September 26, and was attended by a large number. He was a graduate of Shawnee High School, Central Christian College (Oklahoma Christian), and Abilene Christian College (University). He worked 64 years on Main Street and served as preaching minister at Wanette and Tecumseh. He frequently preached at Central. He was truly an elder who realized that teaching the word was one of his greatest responsibilities, and it was his passion to do so.

It will be more challenging to serve our Lord in all the ways we ought without Robert, but it will also be more easily done following the way he laid before us.
