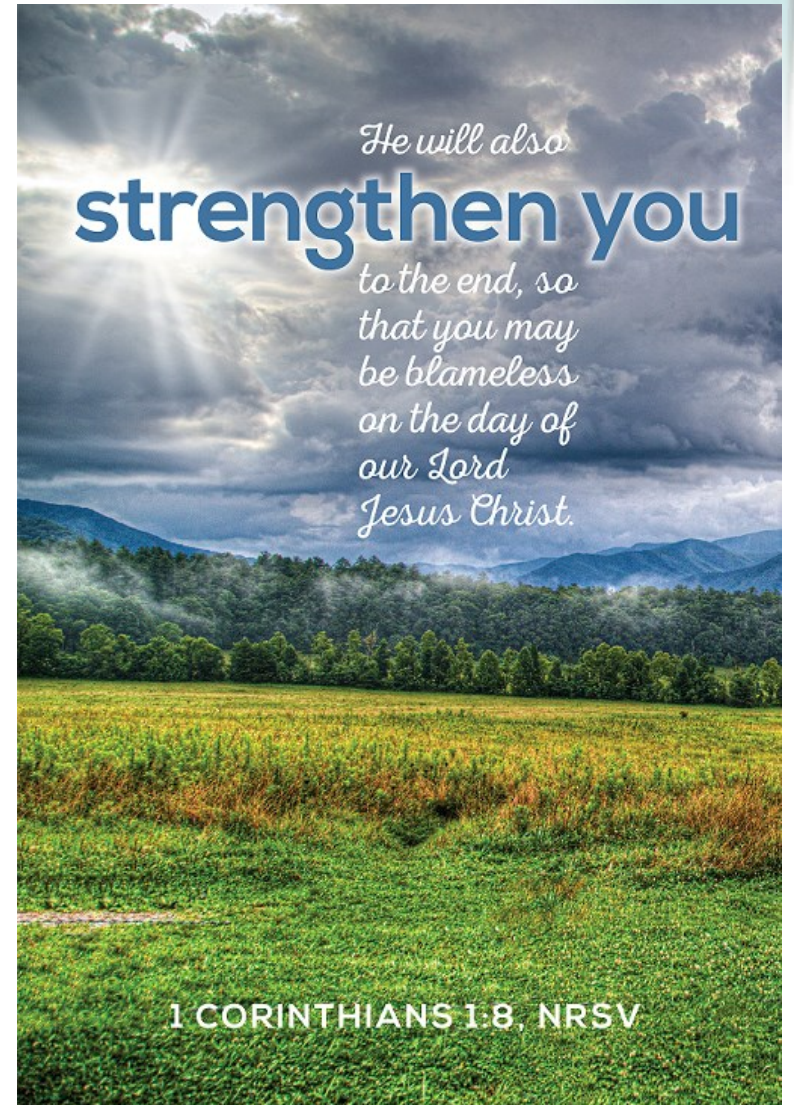

GOD'S GLORY IN US

"Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised. ...Beautiful in elevation, the joy of the whole earth, is Mount Zion in the far north..."; "As is Your name, O God, so is Your praise to the ends of the earth" (Psalm 48:1, 2, 10a).

"... you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body" (1 Corinthians 6:20).

"That He would grant you according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man" (Ephesians 3:16).

Yahweh, the King of His people, should be praised continually. Four elements of His greatness are detected in Psalm 48:1, 2, and 10 and in the prayer of Paul in Ephesians 3:16.

He gives significance to those who put their faith in Him. God stands above and beyond all other kings because He brings to His people worth and meaning. Jerusalem would have been just another city, but God's choice to put His name on it made it the greatest of all cities. The writer of Psalm 48 said of Jerusalem because of God's touch of grace, "Beautiful in elevation, the joy of the whole earth" (v. 2a).

He beautifies whatever He touches. He took Jerusalem, an average-looking city, and made it the envy of the nations of the world. He brought glory and holiness to it. God's glory flows out to those who have close proximity to Him.

He is the believer's stronghold. Those who trust in Him find Him to be their citadel of strength, a fortress of power. They are safe from all enemies—not because of their human military prowess, their wisdom, or their acumen, but because God is with them. He has never failed His people. The kings of the earth looked at Jerusalem and fled in terror because they knew whose hand shielded it (v. 5).

He brings gladness to His people. As they feel the warmth and comfort of His providence and provisions, their hearts break into rejoicing. As a consequence, a confident joy resides in their souls.

One of the most natural things for the faithful child of God to do is to praise Him, for He is his great King. His greatness is unparalleled. He beautifies the place where He dwells. He is the refuge of His people, filling the trusting heart with confidence during the toughest parts of life.

If we do not have true beauty, it is because the beauty of God is not falling upon us.

In prayer, praise God for the glory that He shares with all who live in Him.
