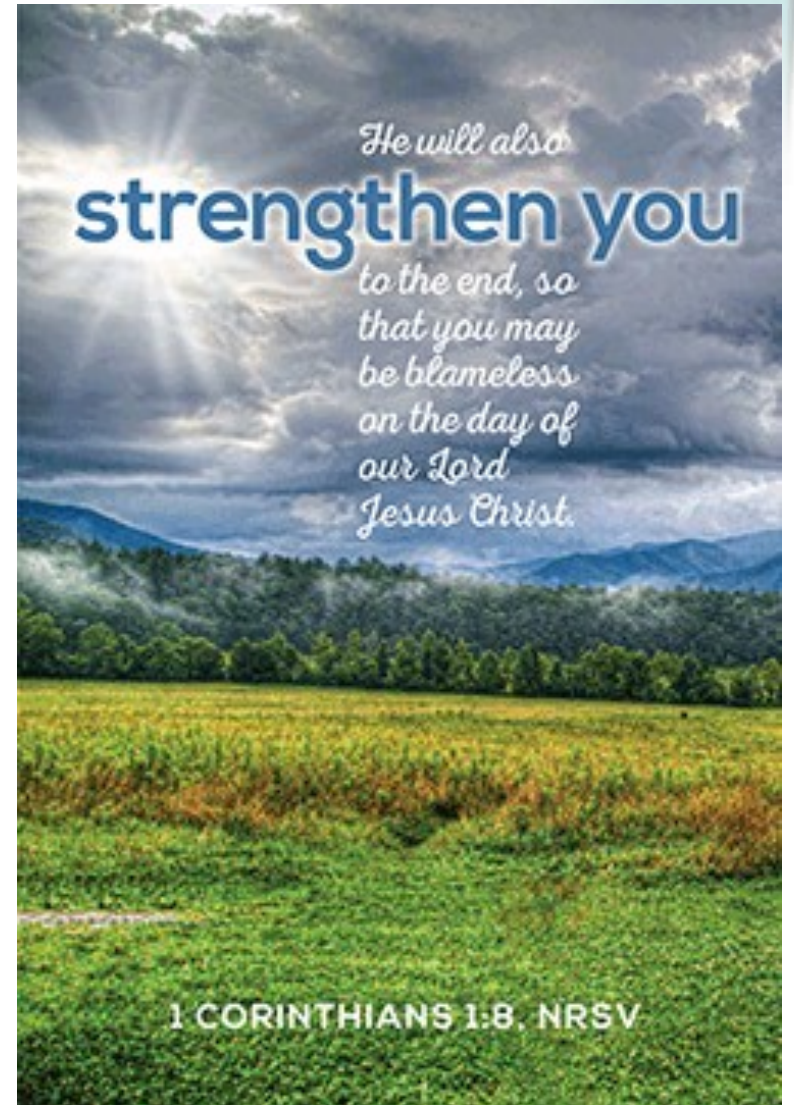

Wonders Too Numerous To Count

"Many, O Lord my God, are the wonders which You have done, and Your thoughts toward us: there is none to compare with You. If I would declare and speak them, they would be too numerous to count" (Psalm 40:5)

As we review the actions of God toward his people, we are able to reach some important conclusions about His nature.

First, He has blessed all who trust in him. There are no exceptions. He has never forsaken any of His trusting children. He has never broken a covenant or violated a promise: He speaks words that are faithful and true.

Second, His deeds are not only kind but also gracious. Kind deeds are generous deeds, but gracious deeds are undeserved deeds. He has loved His people when they did not deserve loving.

When we were down and out and away from God, thoughtless and indifferent, He sought us, found us, and brought us back to His fold as a loving shepherd. He has always given us what we needed, not what we deserved.

Third, He is full of gracious thoughts toward his people. His gracious actions were spawned by gracious thoughts. His compassionate heart has guided His tender hand.

Sometimes we say to one another, "What are you thinking?" We know that the one to whom we are speaking may be thinking an erroneous thought about us. How comforting it is to realize that God is always thinking good, noble, and gracious thoughts about His people!

Fourth, His deeds of grace are continuous and innumerable. These deeds have been unending. There have been so many of them that we could not count them if we really tried. Everywhere we look, we see the hand of God. He has surrounded those who trust in Him with gifts of His faithfulness.

How great our God is! His power transcends our frail ability to comprehend, but so does His grace. It goes out to all, reaches down to the worst, and will lift anyone who receives it all the way to heaven. His wonders are inconceivable, innumerable, and impartial. He loves us with a love that is stronger than death, a love that will not let us go.

When we contemplate God's grace and goodness we become lost in the wonder and depth of it all. We count on His deeds of kindness, but they are too numerous for us to count. We can enjoy them, but we cannot enumerate them.
