“ He Keeps Us In Life”

“Bless our God,...who keeps us in life and does not allow our feet to slip” (Psalm 66:8,9).

“For in Him we live and move and exist” (Acts 17:28a)
“[For you,] who ae protected by the power of God through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time” (1 Peter 1:5)

The writer of Psalm 66 said that God is the One who “keeps us in life”(v.9). This was his poetical way protected them from death.

We can say something similar regarding our spiritual lives. He sustains us spiritually and physically. He has raised us up from death and put us in Christ (Eph 2:5), giving us new life and lavishing upon us all spiritual blessings (Eph 1:3). Furthermore, He renews the Christian's life each day. How does he bring all of this about?

By forgiveness. We enjoy a constant cleansing of sin. As our physical blood cleanses our bodies, even so the precious blood of Jesus keeps us clean in Christ (1 John 1:7). He has not only saved us, but He also keeps us saved and justified in His sight.

Through fellowship. Our brethren revive us spiritually by encouraging us, rebuking us, and teaching us. We are surrounded by a great cloud of witnesses who have gone before us (Hebrews 12:1). They inspire and encourage us by their examples. In the present world, we have a great assembly of brothers ad sisters who are going along with us as we journey to our eternal home. We exhort our fellow Christians and provoke one another to love and good deeds (Hebrews 10:24).

With the guidance of His Word. His words are the words of life because they impart life, strength, character, and hope (Philippians 2:16), and we hold it forth for others to see and receive.

Through the awareness of His presence. Our consciousness that God is in us and with us causes us to look at our power and not at our problems—at our strengths, not at our struggles. Through His glorious presence we are more than conquerors in this life.

Others may forsake us, but the Lord will stand with us and strengthen us to the very end(2 Timothy 4:17).

When we look at what we have in Christ, we say to ourselves with amazement, “How abundant is the life in Christ! Surely those who do not know him do not know what they ae missing.” This life hat we have is not a life that results from positive thinking. It is given and sustained by God Himself! Let us Praise God, the One who keeps us in life!

God through His Son is the author of all life; He gives all of the physical life and the spiritual life we have in Christ. Remember the words of John: “In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men” (John 1:4).
