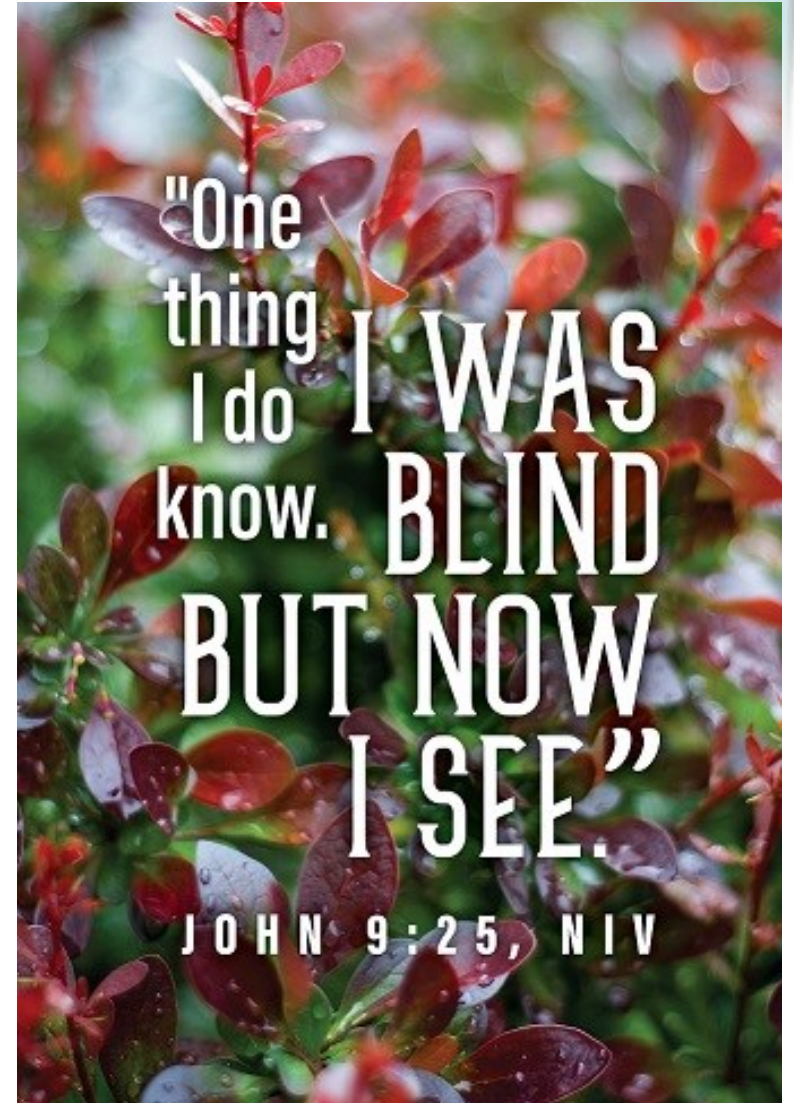

“Yours, O Lord, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the victory and the majesty, indeed everything that is in the heavens and the earth; Yours is the dominion, O Lord, and You exalt Yourself as head over all” (1 Chronicles 29:11).

“And He made from one man every nation of mankind to live on all the face of the earth, having determined their appointed times and the boundaries of their habitation” (Acts 17:26).

In verse 11 of this beautiful prayer of David in 1 Chronicles 29 and also in Paul's speech in Acts 17, we see the sovereignty of our God. He is not only our life, but He is also the Lord over us. His decisions are final, and His actions are uncontested.

He lifts up. He raises up nations in accordance with His will. He controls not only individuals but also races of people. In His great providence He increases the power of some men and decreases the power of others.

His plans are eternal. According to His righteous nature, He keeps His mighty actions within the confines of His eternal purposes. Our plans are fleeting, but God's plans stretch from eternity past to eternity future. Nothing that man does can ultimately destroy God's eternal will.

His people endure forever. Those who put their faith in Him become His people, and they will be blessed eternally. God takes those who have chosen Him and makes them into His nation. His promises undergird them, and His almighty hand shields them.

Every believer can exclaim with Paul, “Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and unfathomable His ways! For who has known the mind of the Lord, or who became His counselor? Or who has first given to Him that it might be paid back to him again? For from Him and through him and to him are all things. To Him be the glory forever. Amen” (Romans 11:33-36).

Nothing should be more encouraging than thinking upon the sovereignty of God. He has no rival in time or eternity. There is no other God besides Him. No one can comprehend His might or absorb His wisdom. The safest place anyone can ever be is within the shadow of His wing.
