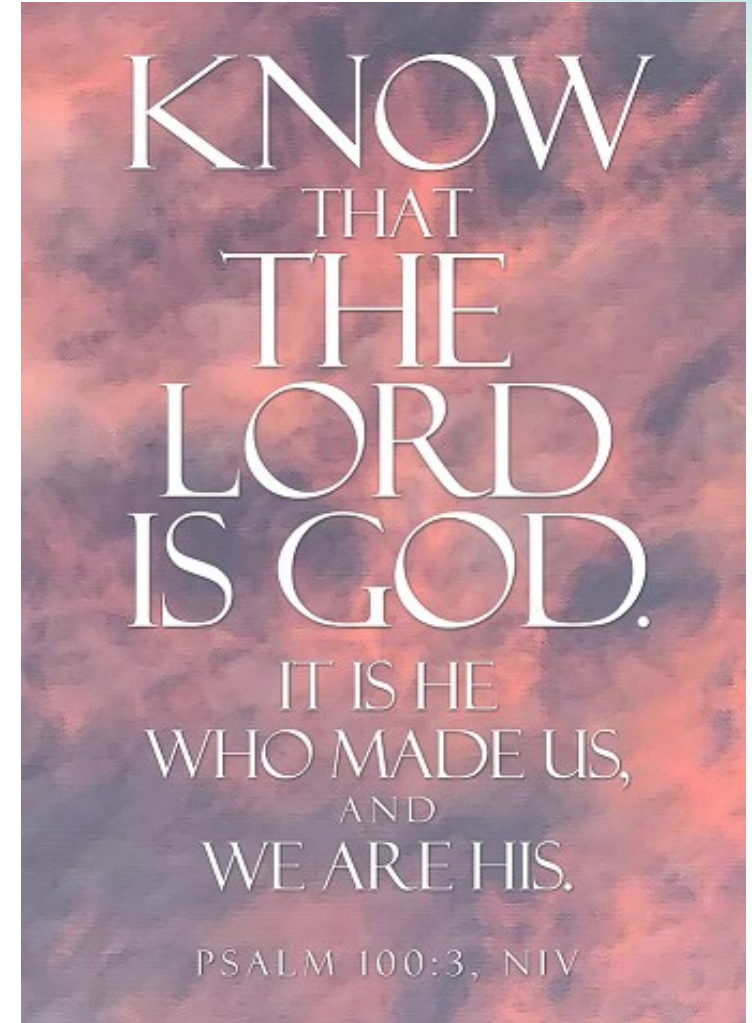

Among All Nations

Romans 1:1-6

An important message was ready to be dispersed into all the world. The messengers were chosen to dispense the news. The news was not entirely new, but it had finally arrived. The reason it was not new per se, was because God had been preparing the world for its arrival. If you scour the scripture you will find the indication of a Savior that was to bring mankind back to God. This Savior has a name, and His name is Jesus. This is the Son of God, the King that was to come into the world and rule over a worldwide kingdom. David could not do this. As important as David was, He could not extend the borders of the kingdom into the world, provide an atoning sacrifice for rebellious lawbreaking, nor bring mankind back to God.

“Paul, a bondservant of Jesus Christ, called to be an apostle, separated to the gospel of God ²which He promised before through His prophets in the Holy Scriptures, ³concerning His Son Jesus Christ our Lord, who was born of the seed of David according to the flesh...”

The verification that this was in fact the Savior, the King, and the promised One, was seen by God’s own confirmation. When Jesus was rejected by man, they put Him to death. This murder was a way of saying that they did not want Him or His message. The news of this Kingdom was something that they had no interest in, and Jesus was blasphemy to their God. God however affirmed that Jesus was in fact the King that was to come into the world. It was His resurrection that showed the world that God’s decision had trumped theirs. It is through Him that grace from God was accessible to the world and messengers were now appointed and sent to disperse this message to the world. The result was a message that, through the messengers and the recipients of God’s grace, told and showed the world the way back to God.

“⁴and declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead. ⁵Through Him we have received grace and apostleship for obedience to the faith among all nations for His name, ⁶among whom you also are the called of Jesus Christ...”

This grace of God was not available in the Old Testament because no atoning sacrifice was available for belligerent sin and lawlessness. The law provided no procedure for prideful rebellion. Although grace is found in the very identity or name of God, it was not available to the world. The reason is because the atoning sacrifice had not arrived yet. God’s identity is also one that punishes the guilty. Christ was that atoning sacrifice. Believing God and receiving a pronouncement of innocence in spite of past sin now is possible through the atoning sacrifice of Christ. That grace is now made available among the nations. It is our job to tell and show the world that through Christ, they can have what we have. It only requires obedience to the faith.
