

Romans 13:11-14

Mornings are hard for many people. Some can hop out of bed and tackle the day without any problems, but some love pushing the snooze button five or six times before even thinking about getting out of bed. I have had times in my life where I hated getting out of bed, and others where I could not wait to get up. Usually, I wanted to get up because there was something about the day that I was looking forward to. Children wake up on Christmas morning and many do not seem to have a problem.
