

Spiritual Conquest

Acts 9

Kingdoms usually spread by means of military conquest. Rome did not get where it was through peace and love. The only peace that Rome ushered in was that of, "there is no war because our foot is on your neck." In this same way Greece was able to expand to India. How else would a kingdom grow?

The Jewish people were trying to suppress the Messianic kingdom conquest in Acts 9. If a nation were to rebel against Rome's rule, how might Rome respond? They would probably respond with violence to squelch the rebellion. This would also potentially prevent other rebellions. Instead of violence, the King asks a key player in the persecution, "...why are you persecuting me?" (Acts 9:4). Instead of executing him or punishing him for his insubordination, the Lord uses Him.

Many years prior, a man named Hananiah was thrown into a fiery furnace for not bowing down and worshiping the king, Nebuchadnezzar. His name in Greek was Ananias, but the Babylonian name given to him was Shadrach (Daniel 1:7). In Acts 5 a man named Ananias was thrown into a proverbial fiery furnace, but God was not with him. Now in Acts 9, another Ananias must go and speak with a Jewish murderer of Christians. This Ananias believed that if he were to have a meeting with Paul it would surely be a suicide mission (Acts 9:13-14). The King's response was that this enemy of the church was about to become a chosen instrument for the expansion of the kingdom.

It is not only impressive that a Jewish enemy is converted to the kingdom, but in chapter 10, a Roman is converted to the kingdom. There are two ways that Rome and the Jews are going to be conquered by Christ's kingdom. First, they would be conquered through judgment for their wickedness, or second, through their repentance from their sins. Many will choose the first option, but the second option is always available. The same is true today. Where the world would have thought that military conquest was the only way to expand a kingdom, Christ is doing it through love and peace.

"Many people shall come and say,
"Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD,
To the house of the God of Jacob;
He will teach us His ways,
And we shall walk in His paths."
For out of Zion shall go forth the law,
And the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.
He shall judge between the nations,
And rebuke many people;
They shall beat their swords into plowshares,
And their spears into pruning hooks;
Nation shall not lift up sword against nation,
Neither shall they learn war anymore" (Isaiah 2:3-4).


