The Sowers and the Reapers

I was reading through the book of John, and this passage caught my eye in a way that it had never caught my eye before.

John 4:34-38

Jesus had just had a conversation with the woman at Jacob's well, and she was going into the city to tell as many people as she could that she had found the Messiah. They were in Samaria. Jacob's well was in Shechem. Both Samaria and Shechem were between Mt. Ebal and Mt. Gerazim. These mountains were where the blessings and curses were pronounced when they entered the land (Deuteronomy 27; Joshua 8). It was here in Shechem that Joshua gathered all of Israel to commit to serving God in their new homes (Joshua 24). It was here that Joseph was buried after the conquest. It was in Shechem that Jeroboam reigned king of Israel while Rehoboam reigned as king of Judah when the kingdom split. After Israel was taken into captivity, in their place Assyria placed people from foreign lands. These foreigners did not know God, and because they were pagan, God sent Lions into the land. They knew that they needed to learn the Jewish ways if this plague would be taken away. They worshipped and feared God but maintained their paganism (2 Kings 17). For this reason, the Jews refused to allow them to help with the reconstruction of the temple (Ezra 4). However, there was still hope that Israel would "return and seek the Lord their God and David their king" (Hosea 3:5). Needless to say, there is much history in Shechem and Samaria.

When Moses was preaching to the people before they came into the land, God said that He would give them cities that they had not built, and vineyards that they had not planted (Deuteronomy 6). Now Jesus is telling His disciples that they are about to "reap" a harvest that they did not "sow" (John 4:38). Jesus says that His "food is to do the will of" the One that sent Him and finish the work (4:34). I found it interesting that Jesus is using similar language as when the Israelites came into the land of promise. Except, the conquest is not war, but labor to reap what God had sown in the Old Testament through the prophets. The Samaritans in John 4 were already ready to be harvested. The woman at the well already was waiting for the Messiah, even though her ancestry was full of rebellion, paganism, corruption, and unfaithfulness. We do not know what hearts are ready to be harvested. We must bring Jesus to everyone.
