Humble and Ready

Zechariah 1:7-11

Zechariah sees an angel on a red horse. This angel appears to be the angel of the Lord. This angel speaks to Zechariah (there is some debate as to whether the angel on the red horse is the angel of the Lord, and whether this is the same angel speaking to Zechariah, but the interpretation should remain the same either way). This angel has authority over the other riders and the other riders answer to him (“Him”, depending on your interpretation).

The other riders report to the angel of the Lord that all is quiet all over the world. This is to imply that the world is going on as if everything is okay. The problem with this is, everything is not okay.

God used the nations of the world to punish the people of God in captivity for 70 years, but they went too far. God wanted them to take the Jews into captivity because of their rejection of God and His word, but instead, they caused them to suffer beyond what was necessary. This was a key problem with Nebuchadnezzar in the book of Daniel. They elevated themselves above God and acted hatefully.

Now God’s message was that the Jews would return home, and they would rebuild the city. This is essential because this is what needed to happen for the Messiah to arrive (according to Daniel 9). God is telling His people, even though they were not on His side, God is still on their side. Even though they had forgotten God, God has not forgotten about them. Even though they do not deserve God’s blessing, God would bless them still. Hopefully, when the Messiah did come, they would be humble and ready. Unfortunately, what we find is the opposite. The question for us is, are we humble and ready to follow and listen to Jesus?

Just like the riders who answered to the angel of the Lord, we are to go throughout the world answering to Jesus. All is not okay if there are people who have not heard the gospel. “Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age” (Matthew 28:19-20)
