## To the Ends of the Earth

Zechariah 9

There is little hope for Syria (Damascus), Phoenicia (Tyre, Sidon), and Philistia (Ekron, Gaza, Ashkelon, Ashdod). All these places have become arrogant and wealthy, but their end is near. Their wisdom (9:2), their wealth (9:3), ships (9:4), their king (9:5), and their arrogance (9:6) will not be able to save them from what is coming.

Jerusalem, on the other hand, has hope in a coming King. The last king that Judah had was taken into captivity, and they have not had a king since. The temple is still unbuilt, and although there is a governor (Zerubbabel), there is no king. As a matter of fact, there will be no king of the Jews until the Messiah. If this is the King Zechariah 9 is talking about then He is going to be humble riding on a donkey, not a war-horse (9:9). There will be peace between Israel and Judah, which we must consider how mind blowing it is that the northern kingdom is still in the picture at this point, and the King will have dominion from the river (Euphrates) to “the ends of the earth” (9:10). This is interesting because it obviously deviates from God’s promise to Abraham. God does not deviate in a contradictory way, but in a bigger way. God told Abraham “To your descendants I have given this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the River Euphrates” (Genesis 15:18). Now, the King will have dominion from the River Euphrates to the ends of the earth. And thus, unlike the

surrounding nations, God will protect His people to bring about this coming King. And by the way, History checks out.

Compare what we’ve read in Zechariah 9 with what we read in Acts 1:8: “But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”
