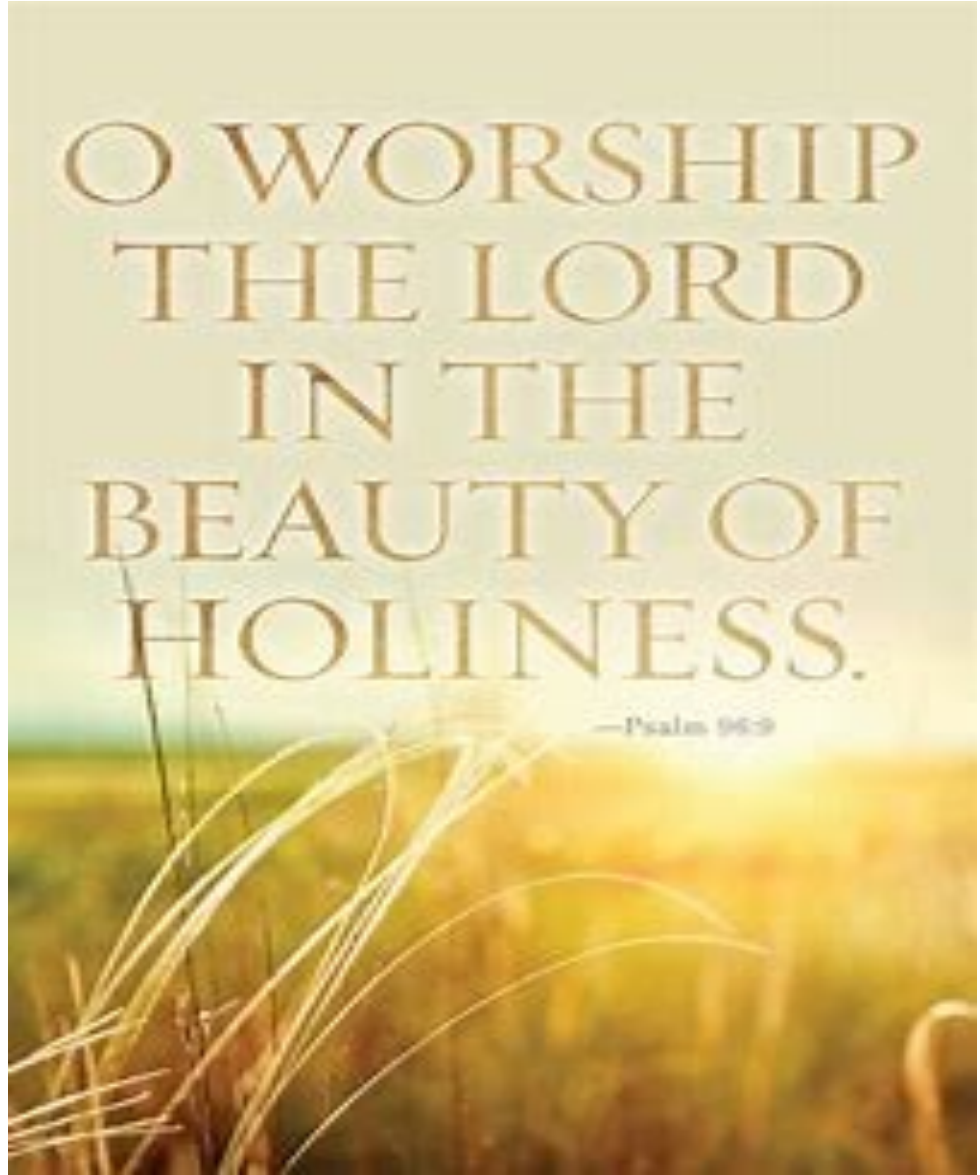

The Work of the Messiah

Zechariah 12-13

So far, we know that the Messiah will be the BRANCH that will bring about forgiveness of sins for the people of God (4:8-9), who will now be made up of many nations of the world (2:11). The Messiah will be a King but will also have the duties of a priest (6:11-13). The kingdom will be peaceful and will be a blessing to the nations (8:4-5; 12-13). The King will ride on a donkey symbolizing peace, not on a horse which symbolizes war (9:9). This peace He will bring to the world and His dominion will be global (9:10). He will be "removed from office" for the price of a slave (30 pieces of silver) but will ultimately replace the worthless shepherds as a good shepherd (11).

Before all of this, the nations of the world will come against Jerusalem. The nations of the world have come up against Jerusalem, and they will continue to do so. This was of course cause for great frustration in Daniel when he discovered that hardship was not going to end when the people came back from captivity. All of this is to confirm the promise that God had made to the house of David. Not only would God protect the house of David, but He would bring vengeance on all that tried to terminate it.

God was going to pour His Spirit on the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem. God says, "then they will look on Me whom they pierced" (12:10). There will be a great morning for the "death" that God seems to be talking about. This is especially intriguing

because it seems as though He is talking about His own death.

As Christians we know that this is exactly what happens. God in the flesh is wounded for our transgressions. Specifically, Jesus is pierced in the side with a spear (John 19:34). Following this, a "fountain" was opened for "sin and uncleanness" (Zechariah 13:1), the "Spirit of grace" was poured out" (12:10), and the Messiah took the throne as King and Priest. The "sword" will strike God's "Shepherd", the "sheep" will scatter (13:7), and the people of God will call on His name; "I will say, 'This is My people'; and each one will say, 'the Lord is my God'" (13:9).
