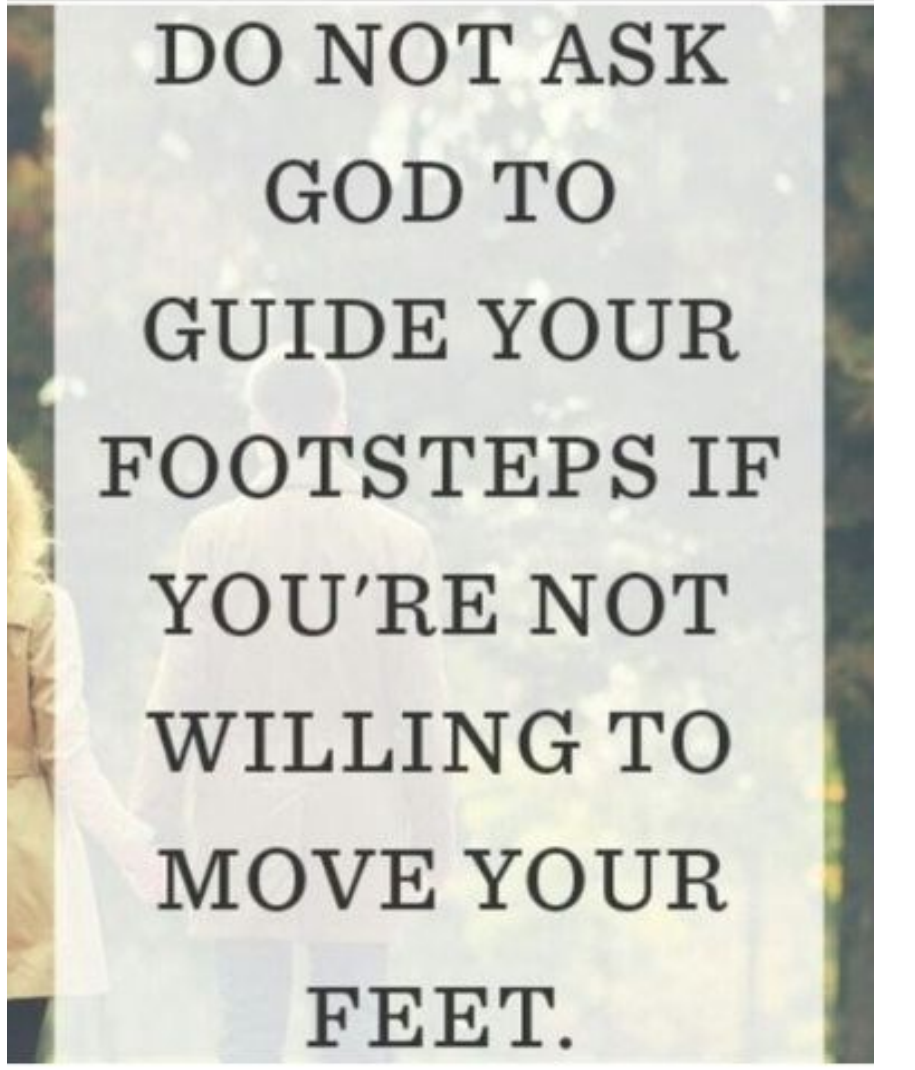

Watch Your Feet

Ecclesiastes 5

“Walk prudently”(5:1), literally means to “watch your feet”. Figuratively it simply means to proceed with reverence. But the reason why this is interesting is because the steps that led into the temple were intentionally different heights and lengths. Have you ever walked up a flight of stairs that did not have regulation stairs? It is amazing how the brain is so accustomed to walking upstairs, but if the stairs are all different heights and lengths, then you really must pay attention.

That is the idea. There was no way to enter the temple without watching your feet. But Solomon is not saying to literally watch your feet, even though if you enter the temple, that is precisely what you will be doing. But rather, to watch your feet spiritually. The object lesson of the temple stairs teaches us a very valuable lesson: entering the house of God should not be taken lightly.

Why do you come to worship? Do you come to learn from God? There is no reason to speak vainly using many words. It is far better to say few words but say the right words.

Making empty promises is one way to speak empty words. If you make a promise, fulfil your promise, because God is going to hold it against you. “Better not to vow than to vow and not pay” (5:4). Instead of letting “your mouth cause your flesh to sin”, it is important to fear God (5:6-7). This is what it means to watch our feet. This is the reverence that is needed in the presence of God.

Paul says it like this:
Ephesians 5:15 “See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise,

16 redeeming the time, because the days are evil. 17 Therefore do not be unwise, but understand what the will of the Lord is.”

Jesus says this:
Matthew 6:6 “But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly. 7 And when you pray, do not use vain repetitions as the heathen do. For they think that they will be heard for their many words.”
