The Money Life

Ecclesiastes 5

Solomon talks about getting money, using money, worrying about money, sacrificing for money, protecting money, losing money, and the emptiness afterwards.

Getting money is not about being satisfied (5:10). If someone is not satisfied in life without money, they'll never be satisfied with it. Satisfaction is an attitude, and the pursuit of wealth can kill satisfaction until you are never satisfied.

Using money is about spending money to make money (5:11). The more money you have, the more mouths there are to feed, the more employees you must hire, the more risk, and the more people that are relying on you. One bad decision and the entire house of cards fall.

Worrying about money makes it hard for the wealthy man to sleep (5:12). Why doesn't money make all the worry go away? Because the person that worries about money is worried about getting it, using it, sacrificing for it, protecting it, and not losing it.

The rich man must make a lot of sacrifices (5:13). Doesn't wealth make life easier? Riches, so often, hurt its owner. The sacrifice alone can be detrimental on a person's health and relationships.

The wealthy person desperately tries to protect their money (5:14). As hard as he tries, he must lose it eventually, because everybody dies. Looking at the life of one that gets, uses, worries about, sacrifices for, protects, and then eventually, loses all their money is truly a tragedy. Solomon calls it a "severe evil." Someone who realizes this eventual end can become miserable, furious, and even physically sick (5:17).

What is the alternative to this depressing life? Understand what money is for, but especially that true joy can exist with or without money. But to the one that has money, it is a blessing from God. Therefore, honor Him with what He has given you and with your life (5:19).
