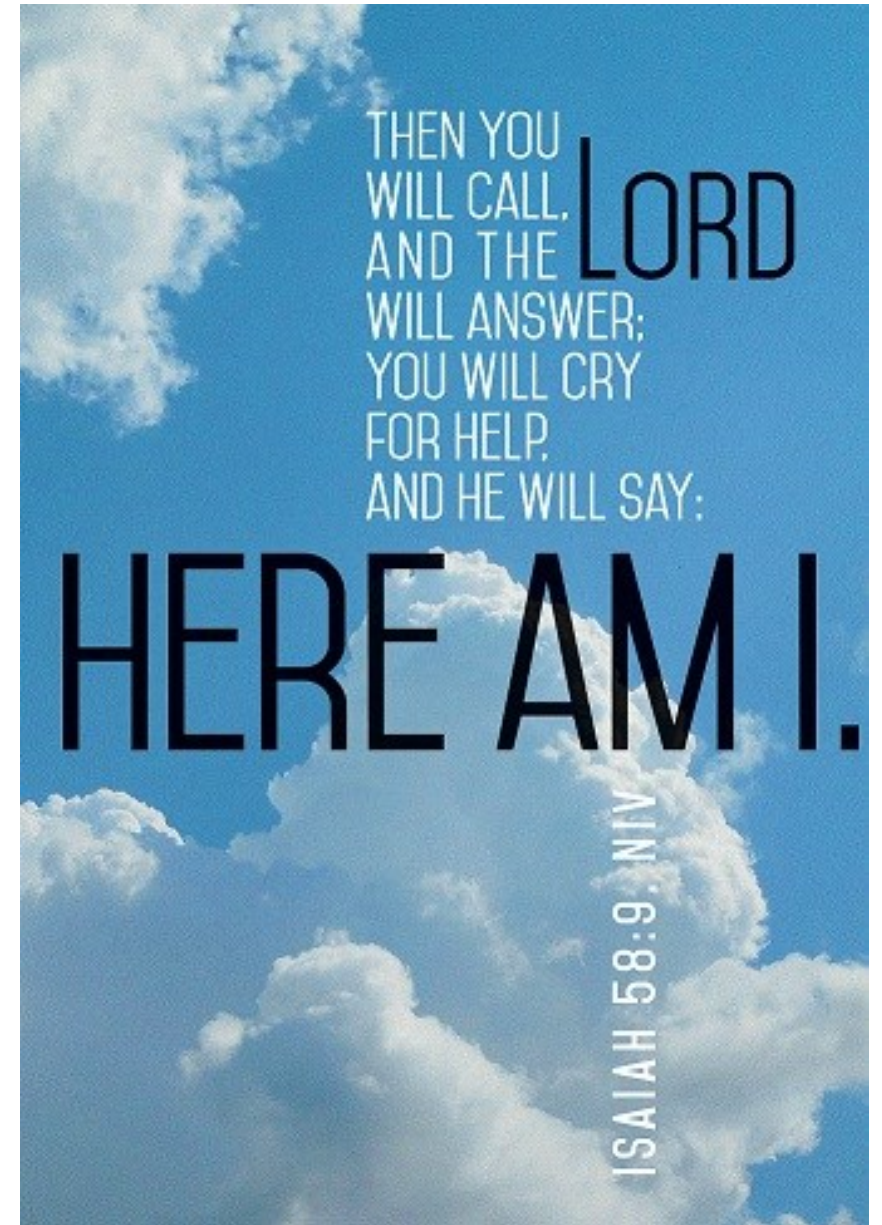

How Much YOU is YOU?

Galatians 2:18

Paul corrects Peter by starting with the separation between Jew and Gentile. This separation is one that Peter is perpetuating through his hypocritical behavior. Therefore, Paul starts here, "We who are Jews by nature, and not sinners of the Gentiles..." (2:15). The problem is, once you acknowledge that righteousness is not found in the law, and instead is found in Christ Jesus, you must acknowledge that you yourself are also a sinner. Needing Christ makes you a sinner, and everyone needs Christ. Which begs the question, "is Christ therefore a minister of sin?" (2:17). Well, of course not. But here's the point.

"For if I build again those things which I destroyed, I make myself a transgressor" (2:18).

If I go back to the things that made me a sinner in the first place, then I am a transgressor or a lawbreaker. Wait a second, how can you be freed from the law and a law breaker at the same time? Transgressor in the Greek is a compound word which literally means to "go beyond". The Latin is transpass, which means to step across (Vincent, Marvin, Word Studies in the New Testament). When I revive the sin in my life, I revive the need for the law, and I "cross the line". When I am made righteous in Christ, the law is not needed. An innocent person has no need to be judged by the law. Thus, we die with Christ and consequently to the law, that we might live to God. No longer does the sin live in us, but Christ

lives in us. This grace produces an observable change in a person's identity. We no longer live for ourselves, but we live for God.

How much of YOU is YOU, and how much of YOU is CHRIST?
