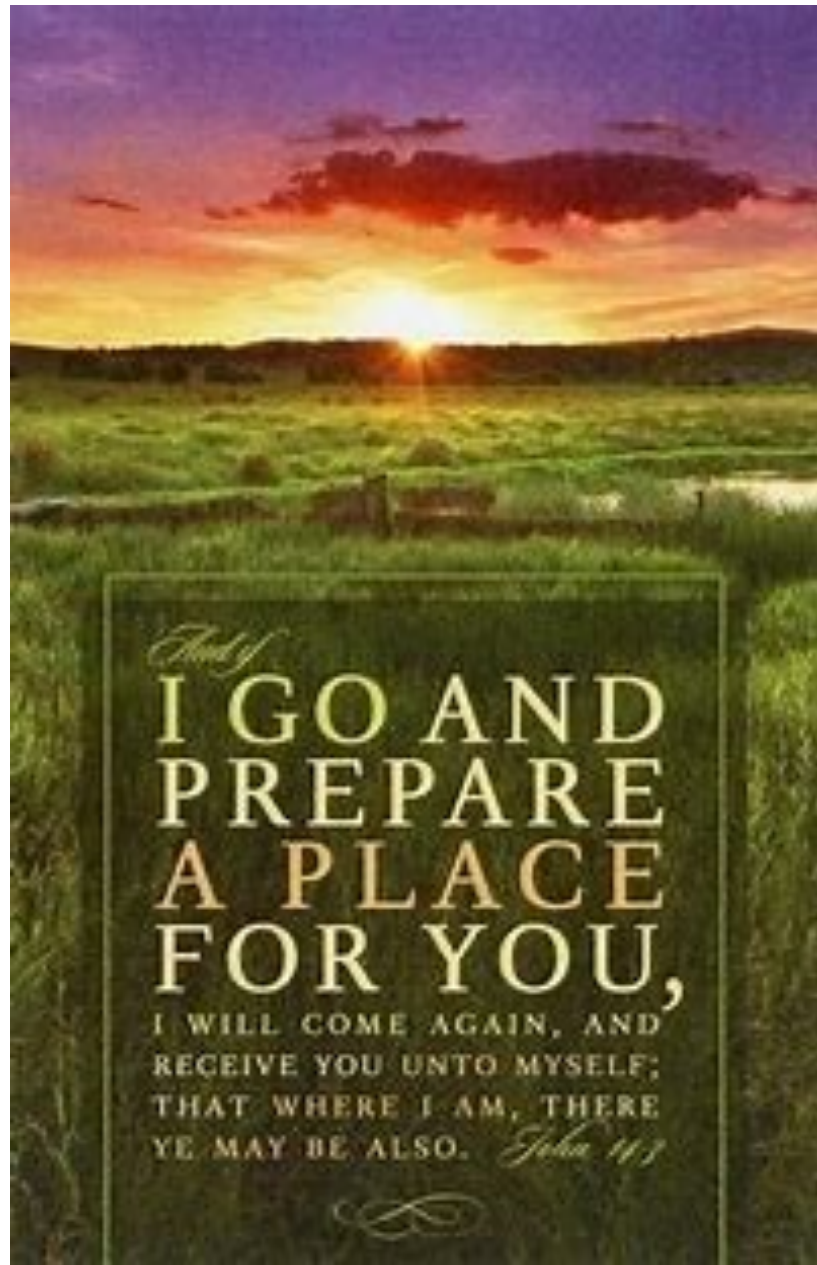

God's Top Ten

Exodus 20

When God instructed the newly born nation of Israel, He began with 10 Commandments from Mt. Sinai. Of all the commands that God will give the nation, these are His top 10. These commands are like the pulse of the Jewish nation; with them they can live with God but without them they cannot. The first four commands have to do with their relationship with God, and the last six have to do with their relationships with each other. This is why Deuteronomy 6:4f and Leviticus 19:18 are excellent summaries of the commands; love God and love people.

In the first four, it is important that Israel knows who their God is, and that is an exclusive choice. They are going to revere God and they are going to honor His time.

In six through ten, I believe that the last command really summarizes the principle; do not want what doesn't belong to you. The other way of saying this is to be satisfied with what God has given you, which is a principle that is all over wisdom literature. God has given you your parents, so honor them; our lives, so don't take someone's life or injure their life; our spouses, so don't take someone that doesn't belong to you; your possessions, so do not take someone else's; and the truth, so don't spread what is not true. Which leads us back to the coveting commands, which is to not want what does not belong to you. Consider the implication of these commands: love your parents, love people, love your spouse, appreciate how God has blessed you, love the truth, and appreciate life as a gift from God. Would this not produce the perfect utopian society? But we as humans are flawed and in need of grace. The Law and the Old Testament prove this point. So, the Messiah is going to come through this nation and remedy this fault.

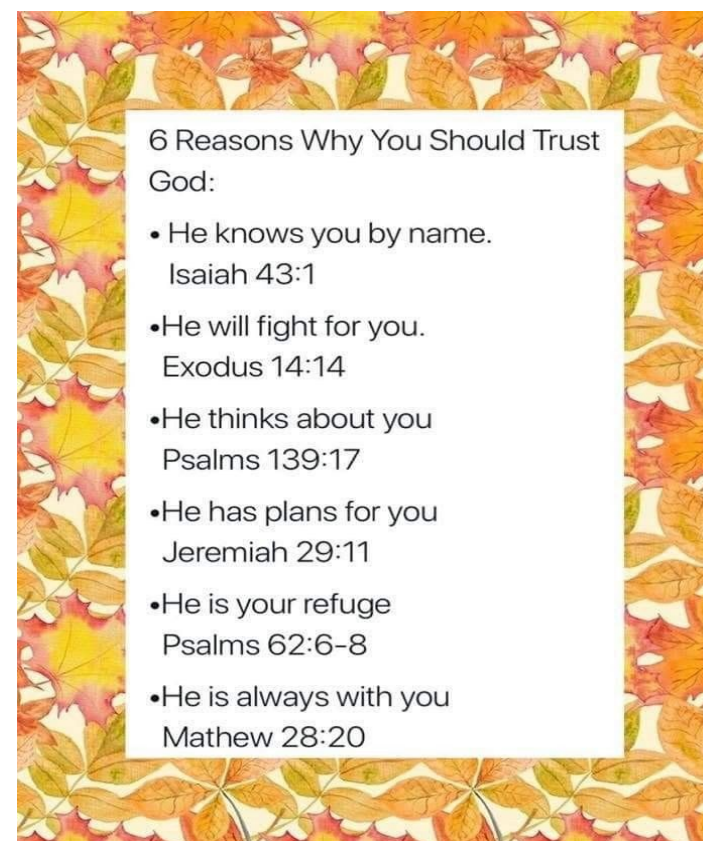
