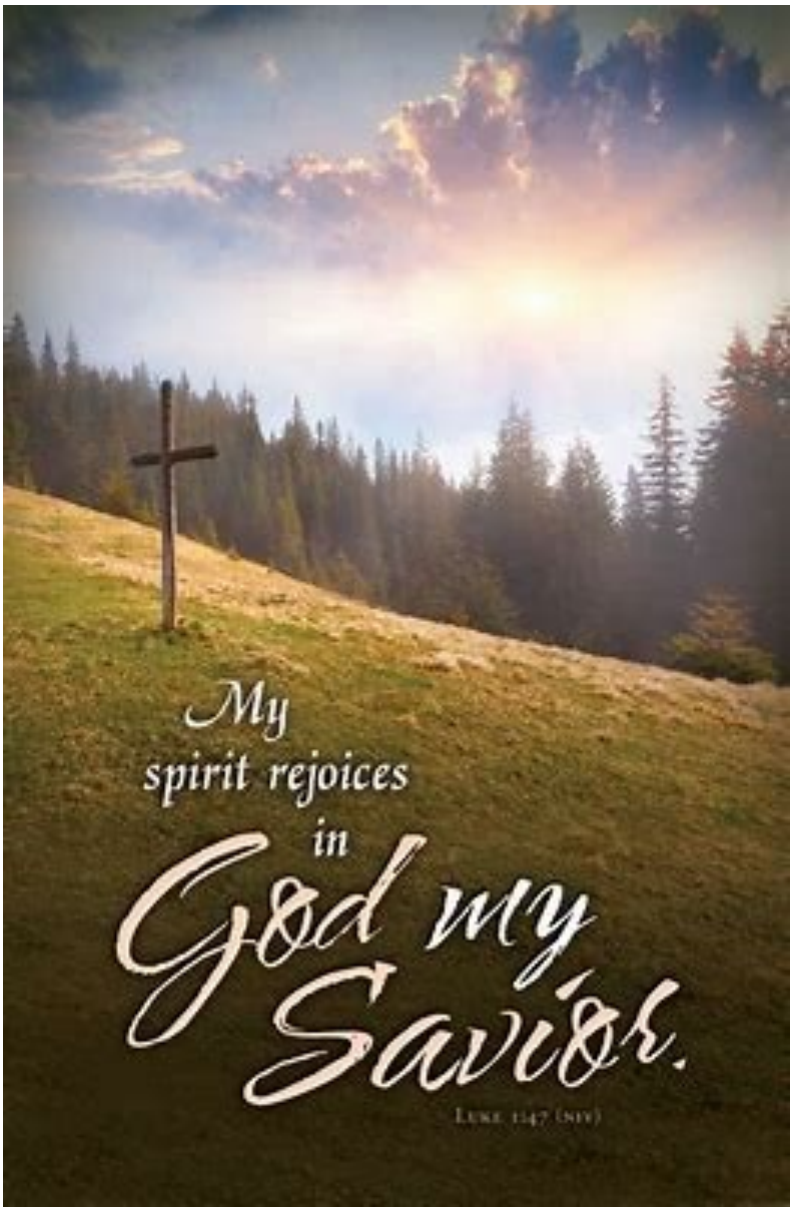

Can Jesus Heal on the Sabbath?

John 5

The Jews sought to kill Jesus because He had healed a man on the Sabbath (John 5:16). Jesus could have left it at that, the people would have still been angry and strongly wanting to kill Him. Jesus, however, says something that elevates their hatred of Him even more.

“My Father has been working until now, and I have been working” (5:17).

Now they are mad because He was “making Himself equal with God” (5:18). They believe that by Jesus making God His Father He is making God and Himself equal. Notice, Jesus does not say, “Our Father,” as would be common among the Jews, but instead, “My Father”. He has intentionally made God the Father exclusive to Himself in this context making the Father and Son in a distinctly unique relationship than anyone else. This is not new to the gospel of John, for example, the Word is God and has been God from the very beginning (John 1). This is obviously what Jesus is trying to imply, and this angry audience got the point loud and clear.

We should ask, does God work? We know that on the seventh day of creation He rested, but does that mean He stopped doing anything at all? Without going to many passages, we can agree with the song, “He’s got the whole world in His hands.” Thus, although an oversimplification, God is doing something daily. The Jews recognized that God does not break Sabbath even though He is daily working. This is because He transcends Jewish Law, and even though the Jewish workweek is modeled after the creation week, God is not bound to the Jewish workweek in His daily providential activities.

D.A. Carson makes an interesting point, “Jesus does not here argue, as he might have, that the Jew’s interpretation of the Sabbath was incorrect—e.g. that in the Old Testament the prohibition of work on the Sabbath had reference to work normally done the other six days of the week, and therefore scarcely applied to the situation where a man, an invalid for thirty-eight years, carried his mat home after a miraculous cure! Instead, Jesus insists that whatever factors justify God’s continuous work from creation on also justify his” (The Gospel According to John). This argument only works if Jesus is God and because of this they wanted to kill Him. Instead of arguing with them about Sabbath, He takes their understanding of Sabbath and proves that He is God. God can heal on the Sabbath.
